

Airplane Emergency Passenger Briefing

✈️ ■ Before Takeoff

- Listen carefully to the crew's safety briefing.
- Locate the nearest emergency exit (and an alternative).
- Count the number of rows between your seat and the exits.
- Fasten your seatbelt and keep it fastened whenever seated.
- Review the safety information card in your seat pocket.

■ ■ During an Emergency

- Stay calm and follow the crew's instructions immediately.
- Leave all personal belongings behind.
- If oxygen masks drop, secure your own mask before helping others.
- If instructed, adopt the brace position: head down, arms over head.
- Assist fellow passengers if you are able.

■ Evacuation

- Move quickly to the nearest usable exit.
- Follow floor lighting to guide you to exits in low visibility.
- Inflate life vests only after leaving the aircraft.
- If using an evacuation slide, jump and slide, do not sit.
- Move away from the aircraft once outside.

■ Special Considerations

- Passengers with children should secure their own safety first.
- Assist passengers with disabilities if you can do so safely.
- Avoid inflating life vests inside the cabin.
- Be aware of potential hazards like smoke or debris.
